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PROJECT SUMMARY:

Stone Child College is a tribally controlled community college. The project design and services are based on competency-based instructional programs with a coherent sequence of courses in Teachers Education, Customer Relations and Construction Technology including hands-on experience for course credit. Stone Child College also proposes to provide professional development and curriculum modification and improvement in “all aspects of an industry,” and develop and disseminate project information and materials to Native American career and technical education practitioners.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- To partnership with the Box Elder and Rocky Boy Communities, the Chippewa Cree Tribe, and the Chippewa Cree Development Corporation on the Rocky Boy’s Indian Reservation as measured by project records, documents, and internal/external evaluation results.
- To provide education, training, job readiness skills, and work experience to a minimum of fifty (50) full-time adults per year in the three NACTEP career/technical education programs, as measured by 85% of participants earning an associate degree and/or a certificate of completion, and 75% being successfully placed in the work experience component or transferring to a four-year institution.

- To provide career and guidance counseling, on the job work experience, and job and continuing education placement services through NACTEP to a minimum of 150 American Indian students on the Rocky Boy's Indian Reservation as measured by participant records, files, statistical data, and internal and external evaluations report.
