RPOS: Lessons Learned

- The Math, Science & CTE Summer Institute provided secondary & postsecondary manufacturing instructors with valuable ways to enhance their math delivery within the context of their curricula. It also provided core academic instructors valuable insights regarding real-world math & science applications.
- The creation of an assessment application that manufacturing instructors utilize in the classroom to document student learning as it occurs.
- Strong collaboration involving high school and technical college manufacturing instructors. Point of emphasis was the development of transcribed (dual) credit.

Technical Assistance
