## Suggested Sub-Indicator Replacement Definitions

Suggested changes to the definitions for the 2008-2009 Perkins IV CAR website

### 3S1 Secondary Level: School Completion

*Sec. 113 (b)(2)(A)(iii) Student rates of attainment of each of the following:*

- (I) A secondary school diploma.
- (II) A General Education Development (GED) credential, or other State-recognized equivalent (including recognized alternative standards for individuals with disabilities).
- (III) A proficiency credential, certificate, or degree, in conjunction with a secondary school diploma (if such credential, certificate, or degree is offered by the State in conjunction with a secondary school diploma).

Current CAR Web Site Definition	Suggested Replacement Definition
<b>General Education Development (GED):</b> A general equivalency diploma.	<b>General Education Development (GED):</b> A general equivalency diploma awarded by recognized state entity with authority to award an official GED certificate.
<b>Diploma:</b> The granting by the state/district/entity demonstrating that the student met the graduation conditions of that granting entity.	<b>Diploma:</b> Document awarded by the state, local school district, or other authorized entity indicating a student has met the graduation conditions of that granting entity and meets the conditions established by Section 1111(b)(2)(C)(vi) of the ESEA.
<b>Certificate:</b> In some states a certificate is granted in lieu of a diploma to students not meeting the criteria of a diploma. Also a certificate can be given by an entity to demonstrate that a student/person has completed a specific program or component of a program.	<p><b><u>Option 1:</u></b></p> <p><b>Certificate:</b> A technical skill proficiency credential, technical skill or CTE program completion certificate, or CTE program degree granted to students in conjunction with a diploma.</p> <p><b><u>Option 2:</u></b></p> <p><b>Certificate:</b> A document awarded by the state, local school district, or other authorized entity in lieu of a diploma to students not meeting the criteria of a diploma. [NOTE: Some states authorize the issuance of a Certificate (of high school completion) while other states do not.]</p>

### 5S1 Secondary Level: Placement

*Sec. 113 (b)(2)(A)(v) Student placement in postsecondary education or advanced training, in military service, or in employment.*

**Note:** Sub-indicators of Postsecondary Education and Advanced Training have been merged into a single sub-indicator definition to be consistent with Perkins IV Section 113 core indicator language.

<b>Postsecondary Education:</b> Formal schooling beyond the	<b>Postsecondary Education or Advanced Training:</b>

secondary level.	Continuation of formal education and training in a recognized or accredited postsecondary institution or training program following secondary school exit.
<b>Advanced Training:</b> Is formal training beyond the high school or secondary level.	
<b>Employment:</b> The former CTE student/concentrator is now employed in a paid position.	<b>Employment:</b> Engagement in lawful activities resulting in compensation.
<b>Military:</b> Participation in one of the branches of the US armed forces.	<b>Military:</b> On active duty in a branch of the United States armed forces (Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard, as well as Army National Guard, Air National Guard or Active Reserves).

### **3P1 and 3A1 Postsecondary and Adult Level: Student Retention or Transfer**

*Sec. 113 (b)(2)(B)(iii) Student retention in postsecondary education or transfer to a baccalaureate degree program.*

**Note:** Pending recommendation suggests elimination of sub-indicators for the core indicator of 3P1/3A1 and report an aggregated performance level.

<b>Current CAR Web Site Definition</b>	<b>Suggested Replacement Definition</b>
<b>Retention:</b> A CTE student/concentrator that is placed and remains in a position (employment, military or further education) the second quarter after graduation from a CTE program.	Eliminate definition. No suggested replacement.
<b>Transfer:</b> A CTE student/concentrator that moves from one program to another. Moves from 2 year program to another 2 year program or 4 year program.	Eliminate definition. No suggested replacement.

### **4P1 and 4A1 Postsecondary and Adult Level: Student Placement**

*Sec. 113 (b)(2)(B)(iv) Student placement in military service or apprenticeship programs or placement or retention in employment, including placement in high skill, high wage, or high demand occupations or professions.*

<b>Current CAR Web Site Definition</b>	<b>Suggested Replacement Definition</b>
<b>Employment:</b> The former CTE student/concentrator is now employed in a paid position.	<b>Employment or retention in employment:</b> Engagement in lawful activities resulting in compensation and sustained employment for an established period of time.
<b>Retention:</b> A CTE student/concentrator that is placed and remains in a position (employment, military or further education) the second quarter after graduation from a CTE program.	
<b>Military:</b> Participation in one of the branches of the US armed forces.	<b>Military:</b> On active duty in a branch of the United States armed forces (Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard, as well as Army National Guard, Air National Guard or Active Reserves).

**Apprenticeship:** A CTE student/concentrator who is working under the guidance of a skilled person, for a specified period of time, in order to acquire a skill.

**Apprenticeship:** Participation in a formal preparation program leading to a journeyman level recognition in a skill trade and acknowledged by union and non-union employers.
