

REPORTING EFFECTIVENESS OF TECH PREP

1. Narrative Report

We must report in writing according to the new CAR. Section 205 of Perkins IV requires each eligible agency that receives a tech prep allotment to annually prepare and submit to the Secretary a report on the effectiveness of the tech prep programs that were assisted, including:

- A. A description of how grants were awarded in the State during the program year.
- B. A listing of the consortia and their funding amounts for the year.
- C. Review the accountability data submitted by your State's consortia as described in section 203(e) of Perkins IV. A data summary table is applicable. This should include both Section 113, and 203.
- D. Indicate the total number of consortia that failed to meet an agreed upon minimum level of performance for any of the indicators of performance.
- E. Note any trends in the performance of the consortia such as indicator that were most commonly missed and for how many years they have not met the indicator

2. Section 113 Reporting

- i. Data – Tech prep as a subset of students (just as in the past)
- ii. 3 NCLB indicators for secondary are all that is needed in 07/08

3. Student Definitions that are in the law

- i. Secondary Tech Prep Student
- ii. Postsecondary Tech Prep Student

4. Section 203 Reporting:

This is the new section. Items for discussion:

- i. Secondary Denominator-Student who graduated last year?
- ii. Postsecondary Denominator-1TPT1-Graduate? Remaining are those that LEFT Postsecondary?

5. Data Collection and Sharing (among secondary, postsecondary and consortia).
