

REPORTING EFFECTIVENESS OF TECH PREP OUTLINE FOR DISCUSSION

1. We must report in writing according to the new CAR:

Section 205 of Perkins IV requires each eligible agency that receives a tech prep allotment to annually prepare and submit to the Secretary a report on the effectiveness of the tech prep programs that were assisted, including:

 - A. A description of how grants were awarded in the State during the program year.
 - B. A listing of the consortia and their funding amounts for the year.
 - C. Review the accountability data submitted by your State's consortia as described in section 203(e) of Perkins IV. A data summary table is applicable. This should include both Section 113, and 203.
 - D. Indicate the total number of consortia that failed to meet an agreed upon minimum level of performance for any of the indicators of performance.
 - E. Note any trends in the performance of the consortia such as indicator that were most commonly missed and for how many years they have not met the indicator
2. The reporting of Tech Prep Effectiveness includes Section 113 with Tech Prep as a subset just like it has in the past.
3. Section 203 is the new section. Items for discussion:
 - a. Definitions that are in the law:
 - i. Secondary Tech Prep Student
 - ii. Postsecondary Tech Prep Student
 - iii. Secondary Denominator-Student who graduated last year?
 - iv. Postsecondary Denominator-1TPT1-Graduate? Remaining are those that LEFT Postsecondary?
4. Data Collection and sharing might me included in the write-up.
