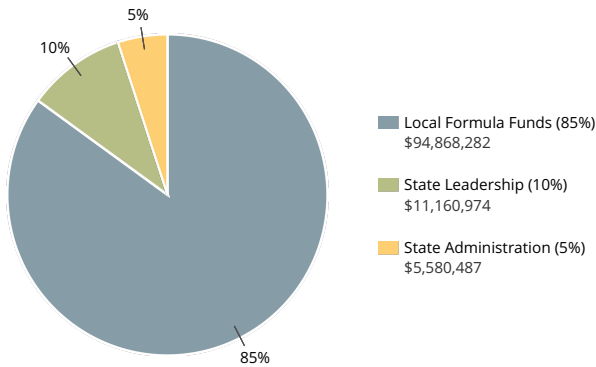

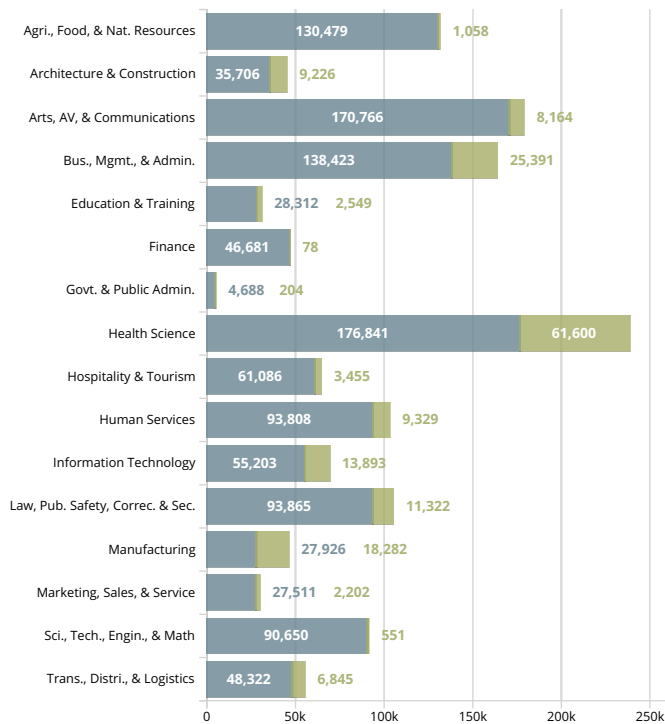

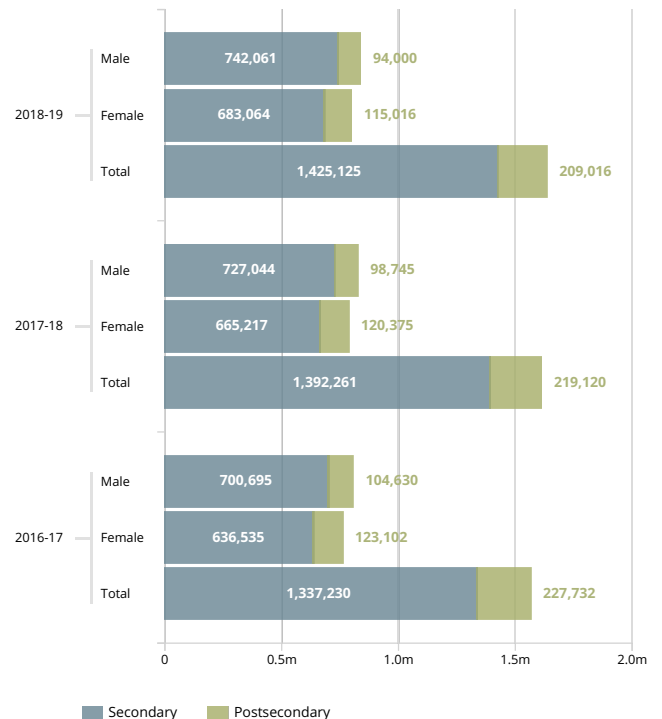

CTE Participant Enrollment for Most Recent 3 Years

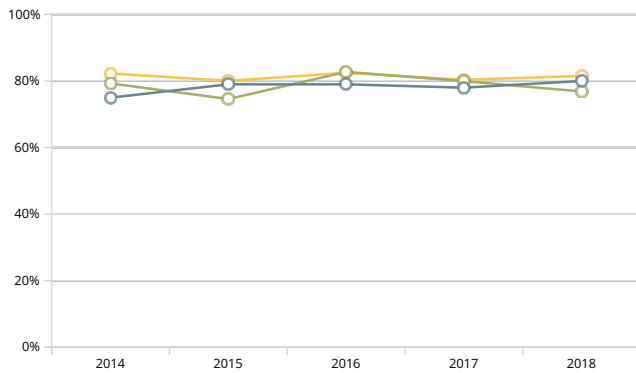

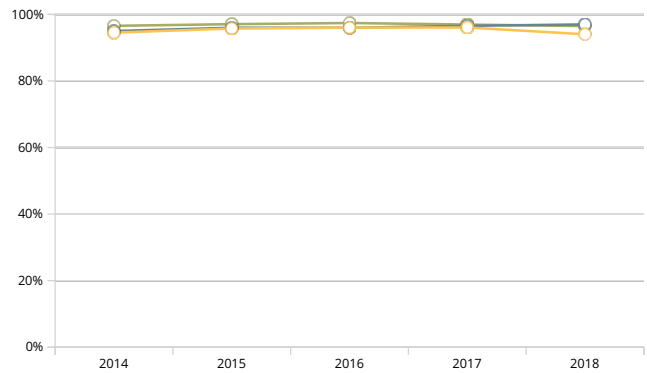

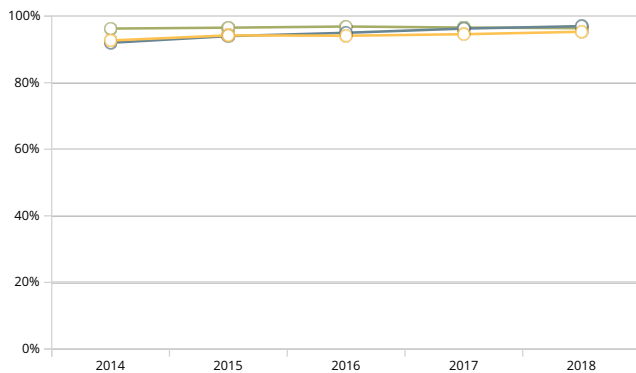
Performance on Select Perkins IV Core Indicators for Most Recent 5 Years — 2S1: Technical Skills Attainment



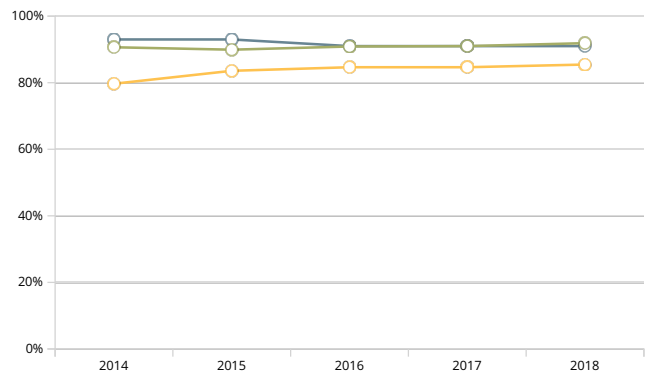
Performance on Select Perkins IV Core Indicators for Most Recent 5 Years — 3S1: Secondary School Completion



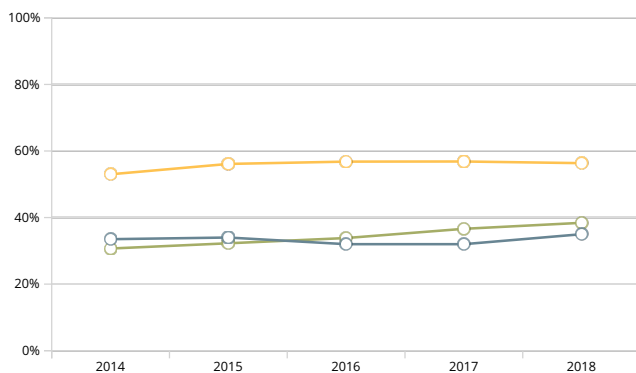
Performance on Select Perkins IV Core Indicators for Most Recent 5 Years — 4S1: Student Graduation Rate



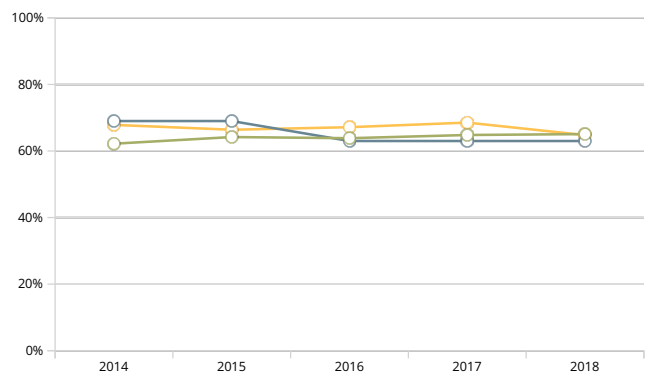
Performance on Select Perkins IV Core Indicators for Most Recent 5 Years — 1P1: Technical Skill Attainment
